To Print a PDF Document:

- 1 To select pages to print, click Thumbnails in the Thumbnails palette. You can Ctrl-click (Windows) or Command-click (Mac OS) thumbnails to select non-consecutive pages, or Shift-click to select a consecutive range of pages. You can also select a consecutive page range in the Print dialog box.
- 2 Use File > Page Setup to set general printing options. The available options will vary with different printers and drivers.
- 3 Click the Print button, or choose File > Print. Specify the printer, page range, number of copies, and other options, and click OK.

E-mailing Documents from Acrobat (Windows only)

To e-mail directly from a PDF you need the Acrobat 4.0 Application. This feature is not available through Acrobat Reader.

You can send an e-mail message from Acrobat with a PDF document as an attachment. Acrobat uses the Messaging Application Program Interface (MAPI) to communicate with your e-mail application. Most e-mail applications come with a MAPI server to handle this interface.

Before you begin, make sure that your e-mail application is working outside Acrobat, and set it up to use its MAPI server. When you choose the Send Mail command in Acrobat, the MAPI server opens a new outgoing message with the current PDF document attached.

For information on running the MAPI server and on setting options that affect the attached PDF document, refer to documentation supplied with your e-mail software.

To e-mail a PDF Document from Acrobat:

- Open the document you want to attach to an e-mail. 1
- 2 Choose File > Send Mail.
- 3 If you have not saved the document, enter a filename and location in the Save As dialog box, and click Save.
- 4 If you have not logged into the e-mail application, enter your password in the Log In dialog box, and click OK.
- 5 Address and write the e-mail message in the new message window. Then click Send.

View Manuals

The files on this CD are in Adobe Portable Document Format (PDF). They can be viewed with version 4.0 of Acrobat Reader which is included on this CD.

Many manuals were created directly from electronic files, maintaining the page layout and structure of the original files. Text is searchable and vector graphics maintain quality when magnified.

Some manuals were originally printed copies which have been scanned and transformed into electronic files using Acrobat Capture. The text in these manuals is searchable. The graphics are in bitmap format so lose quality when viewed at higher magnification.
